













Curriculum Intent Statement – Modern Foreign Languages (MFL)

At St. Winefride's, our MFL (Modern Foreign Languages) focus is on the understanding of French, with the essential aims of acquiring the knowledge and the skills of language learning, along with the language itself. We use the 'Salut!' scheme to ensure progression and enjoyment of French in school and to promote fluency in speaking, listening, reading and writing French. This scheme also supports exploring the cultural capital of another country through learning about its culture and traditions. Staff and children use French greetings, commands and prayers regularly. The children at St. Winefride's experience a high quality languages education which ignites children's curiosity and deepens their understanding of the world. This experience is enriched by extra-curricular clubs being offered, such as German. Learning MFL at St. Winefride's provides excitement and develops an eagerness to learn; it supports creative thinking and challenges children to retain, recall and use critical information. It allows students to express their opinions, to develop their independence and supports the development of skills and qualities that may be applied in all areas of the curriculum.
