The topics I am focusing on this term are:

Historical Enquiry Question: How have holidays changed since Victorian times?

History – Seaside holidays in the past

Geography Enquiry Question – Which beaches can I visit on the Wirral

Geography – Our local area - Wirral

Through **R.E.** I am considering:

The Resurrection: The children will know that we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus at Easter. They will find out that Jesus rose from the dead on the first Easter Sunday and that he then appeared to the disciples in the Upper Room. They will hear that Jesus helped the disciples to understand that he was truly alive and how he convinced Thomas who did not believe. Children will find out that Jesus returned to heaven after forty days.

Miracles: The children will hear how Jesus showed his great power when he calmed the wind and waves. They will learn that compassion motivates many people to act for the good of others. They will experience how Jesus showed his love for sick people when he cured a man who was paralysed and responded to the faith of the blind man with compassion. They will hear how Jesus performed his first miracle at the request of his Mother.

English Pathways:

A range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry: Toys In Space by Mini Grey

Punctuate sentences using a capital letters and a full stop, some question marks and exclamation marks

Reading:

In Year 1 the children take part in 3 reading sessions a week with a member of staff. The children read a fully decodable book that is matched to their progress in Phonics. Each session focuses on a different skill: decoding, prosody and comprehension.

The children bring this book home on Thursday along with another phonics book and a reading for pleasure book they have chosen from our class library.
