English Pathways:

In English we will read *Coming to England* by Floella Benjamin.

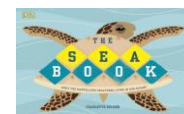


We will be working on the following skills:

- Group related ideas into paragraphs
- Expanded noun phrases
- Conjunctions
- Build a varied and rich vocabulary
- Use prepositions to express time, place and cause

Reading Pathways:

In our reading lessons we will read *The Sea Book* by Charlotte Milner.



We will be working on the following skills:

- Identify main ideas drawn from more than one paragraph and summarise
- Identify how language, structure and presentation contribute to meaning
- Identify themes and conventions in a wide range of books
- Identify how language, structure and presentation contribute to meaning

Pathways to Spell: In our spelling lessons we will be learning:

- Suffixes: -ness, -ful, -less and -ly; -al and -il; -el and -le
- Common exception words

In **Maths**, I am working on:

- Daily practice of oral and mental skills.
- Mental calculation strategies.
- Place value – represent and partition numbers up to 1000. Comparing numbers up to 1000. Find 1, 10 and 100 more and less than a given number.
- Addition and subtraction – add and subtract 2 and 3 digit numbers, with and without exchanges
- Multiplication and division – recall and use multiplication facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Learn the 3, 4 and 8 times tables
- Problem solving

In **Science**, I am working on:
Autumn 1- Skeletons, Nutrition and Diet
Autumn 2- Food Waste & Rocks

In **PE**, I am working on:
Invasion Games

In **Art**, I am learning:
Exploring cave paintings
In **DT**, I am learning to:
Design and make Bronze Age bread

Relationships and Sex Education:

The children will learn:

LKS2 Module One: Created and Loved by God explores the individual.

Unit 1: The Sacraments of Baptism and Reconciliation.

Unit 2: Me, My Body, My Health encourages children to celebrate similarities and differences between people, including our God-given bodies and the things they enable us to do!

In computing, the children will learn: e-safety, Computing systems and networks – Connecting computers

In Music, the children will learn:

We will study the historical context of musical styles: R&B, Western Classical, Musical, Motown, Soul. We will learn basic instrumental skills by playing tunes in varying styles and have an introduction to the language of music, theory and composition.

In MFL, the children will learn: French greetings; how to talk introduce myself and how to talk about my family in French.
