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School Uniform Policy

The smart appearance of our pupils reflects our high standards and the pride we all have in our school. The uniform at St. Winefride's Catholic Primary School is:

Winter Uniform (Autumn and Spring Term)

- Lemon yellow polo-shirt with or without the school emblem
- Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan, preferably with the school emblem
- Dark grey trousers
- Dark grey skirt or dark grey pinafore dress
- Dark grey tights or white socks with a skirt/pinafore dress
- Grey socks with trousers
- Flat black shoes, no trainers
- Sensible black boots may be worn during very cold periods
- No make-up, false nails or nail varnish

Summer Uniform (Summer Term)

- Lemon yellow polo-shirt with or without the school emblem
- Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan, preferably with the school emblem
- Dark Grey shorts or trousers
- Lemon yellow, gingham summer dress
- White socks to be worn with the summer dress
- Grey socks to be worn with dark grey shorts or trousers
- Flat black shoes, no trainers
- Flat sandals in black or white may be worn on warmer days
- No make-up, false nails or nail varnish

Hair:

- Hair, past shoulder length, must be fully tied back at all times.
- Hair accessories should be either dark grey, navy blue or lemon yellow, in keeping with the school colours and must be of a reasonable size. Please speak to the school office, if you require clarification.
- Short hair should be an appropriate length, with no shaved patterns.

Jewellery

An analogue watch may be worn or a digital watch, which must not have direct access to the internet.

One pair of plain stud earrings may be worn; these must be removed on PE/swimming days.

No other jewellery should be worn.

PE

Navy blue round necked t-shirt, preferably with the school emblem

Navy blue shorts

Plain navy blue jogging bottoms, during winter months, not compulsory

Plain navy blue hooded sweatshirt, during winter months, not compulsory

Black pumps to be worn in KS1 and Reception classes

White or black trainers may be worn in KS2

Coats and bags

School bags should be of an appropriate size and colour

PE kit bags/ swimming bags should be of an appropriate size and colour

Coats should be appropriate for school wear and clearly labelled with your child's name

Digital Technology

We strongly advise against children bringing digital devices into school for safeguarding reasons. Where it is necessary to have them in school, devices should be turned off and then handed to either their class teacher or to the school office at the beginning of the day. They must collect them at the end of the day. Devices should not be switched on, until they have left the school property. No devices are allowed in bags and pockets etc. Whilst we will endeavour to look after such devices that are left with us, St. Winefride's Catholic Primary School will not accept any responsibility for loss or damage to any digital devices that are brought into school.
